GENERAL PURPOSE

Perform a variety of duties related to the **Youth Program Lead - Tennis**. Monitor activities at the assigned location of the sports programs. Communicate in a respectful, friendly, and professional manner to participants, parents, and members of the public. Ensure the site is cleaned up and that all sports-related equipment is collected and stored as directed by the Program Coordinators.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Employee must be able to:

- Interact positively with youth, parents, and spectators.
- Know of, or have aptitude to learn, team play, and rules.
- Communicate rules to youth participants.
- Officiate sporting competitions.
- Signal to participants and other officials when infractions occur.
- Inspect sports equipment.
- Learn and follow the recreation team sports rules taught by the Recreation Program Coordinators.
- Enforce rules to ensure the safety of all participants, spectators, and employees.
- Make judgment split-second calls.
- Maintain a safe, fun, organized, and clean environment.
- Demonstrate positive attitude and behavior.
- Must maintain composure, keep emotions in check, and avoid aggressive behavior, even in difficult situations.
- Work independently; the job requires being reliable, responsible, and dependable.

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- Respond to emergencies as required, following safety and emergency action plan guidelines. Ensure required paperwork is completed.
- Ability to track hours and submit hours for approval using a phone app.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Education and Experience
 - A. Familiarity with various sports, a positive team environment, and officiating is preferred but not required.
 - B. Sufficient experience or knowledge to demonstrate an ability to perform the above duties.
2. Ability to interact positively and attentively with youth; must give instructions effectively and be able to communicate verbally and in writing.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS / CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

1. Applicants must be age 15 or older to apply.
2. Must pass a background screen.
3. Must pass a drug screen.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

Incumbents of the position perform work outdoors. Tasks require a variety of physical activities, generally involving muscular strain, related to lifting, walking, standing, stooping, sitting, reaching, and running. Talking, hearing, and seeing are essential to performing required job functions. Common eye, hand, and finger dexterity exists. Mental application utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability, and discriminating thinking and some creative problem solving. Must be able to lift and carry up to 40 lbs.
