GENERAL PURPOSE

Officiate youth flag football games while promoting a safe, positive, and enjoyable recreational experience for players, coaches, parents, and spectators. Enforce league rules fairly and consistently, maintain control of the game, communicate professionally, and ensure participant safety at all times. Assist with the setup, inspection, collection, and storage of sports equipment as directed by the Recreation Program Coordinators.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Employee must be able to:

- Officiate youth flag football games in accordance with league rules.
- Learn, understand, and consistently enforce youth flag football rules.
- Make fair, impartial, and timely decisions during games.
- Exercise sound judgment and split-second decisions while maintaining control of the game.
- Be able to explain rule interpretations to coaches and players respectfully and professionally.
- Enforce rules to ensure the safety of all players, spectators, and employees.
- Signal to players and other officials when infractions occur.
- Assist with field setup, cleanup, and proper storage of equipment.
- Complete required reports, incident documentation, waivers, and other required paperwork.
- Maintain a safe, fun, organized, and clean environment.
- Demonstrate dependability by arriving on time and prepared for scheduled assignments.
- Stay calm and confident while making calls, handling disagreements, and communicating with players, coaches, parents and spectators.

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- Respond to emergencies as required, following safety and emergency action plan guidelines.
- Accurately record and submit hours worked using the District's electronic timekeeping system.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Education and Experience
 - A. Familiarity with various sports, a positive team environment, and officiating is preferred but not required.
 - B. Sufficient experience or knowledge to demonstrate an ability to perform the above duties.
2. Ability to interact positively and attentively with youth; must give instructions effectively and be able to communicate verbally and in writing.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS / CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

1. Must be 16 or older.
2. Must consent to a background screen.
3. Must pass a pre-employment drug screen.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

Incumbents of the position perform work outdoors. Tasks require a variety of physical activities, generally involving muscular strain, related to lifting, walking, standing, stooping, sitting, reaching, and running. Talking, hearing, and seeing are essential to performing required job functions. Common eye, hand, and finger dexterity exists. Mental application utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability, and discriminating thinking and some creative problem solving. Must be able to lift and carry up to 40 lbs.

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to safely perform each essential job duty satisfactorily. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable qualified individuals with disabilities to perform essential job functions.
